

Transpyr Adventure 2013

The new edition of Transpyr Adventure 2013 - don't confound it with the Transpyr Challenge which is carried out over seven individual stages from April to September - will start on July 6th in Roses (Girona) and will end on July 13th in San Sebastián. It's an adventure comprising eight stages crossing the Pyrenees mountain range - from east to west - covering a distance of 820km and 20.300m of accumulated ascent.



The Transpyr - also known as the "coast to coast mountain bike epic" as it connects the Mediterranean Sea and Atlantic Ocean, passing through Catalonia, Aragon, Navarra and Euskadi - is thought for experienced bikers. In fact, the route has been designed to run through the minimum number of paved roads possible, incorporating several climbs and trails of low cyclability, covering 8 stages:

→ Roses (Girona), → Camprodón (Girona), → Seu d'Urgell (Lleida), → Pont de Suert (Lleida),
→ Aínsa (Huesca), → Jaca (Huesca), → Isaba (Navarra), → Elizondo (Navarra) → San Sebastián (Donostia).



For participants who do not want to cover the entire trail, the organization has created two excellent alternatives:



- On the one hand, the Transpyr East, covering, in four stages, the 460km between Roses and Aínsa (Huesca).
- And, on the other hand, the Transpyr West, covering, in four stages, the 359km separating the cities of San Sebastián and Aínsa.



Each stage is organized by the cycling clubs of the respective cities the Adventure will pass through.

The Transpyr is, without doubt, the result of a well thought project, which, in just four years, has gained a consolidated position in the world of mountain biking.
